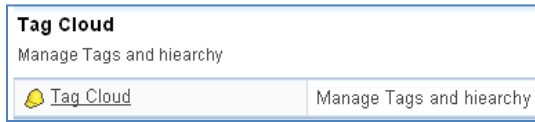
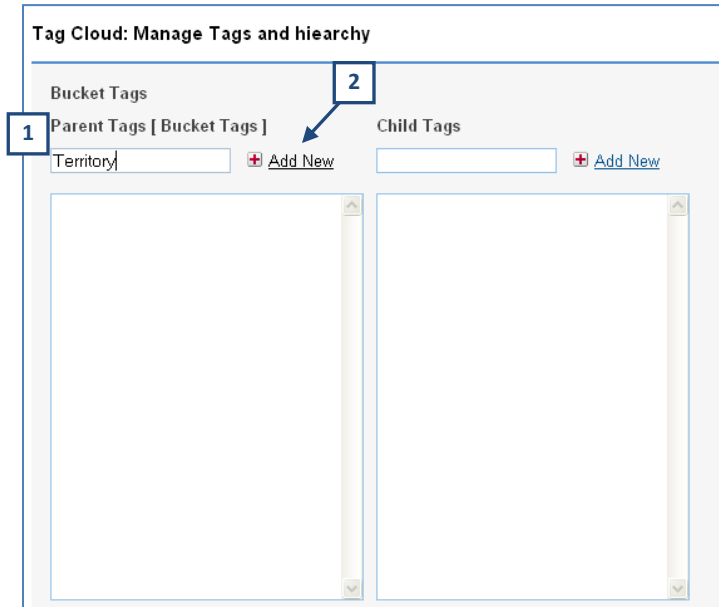


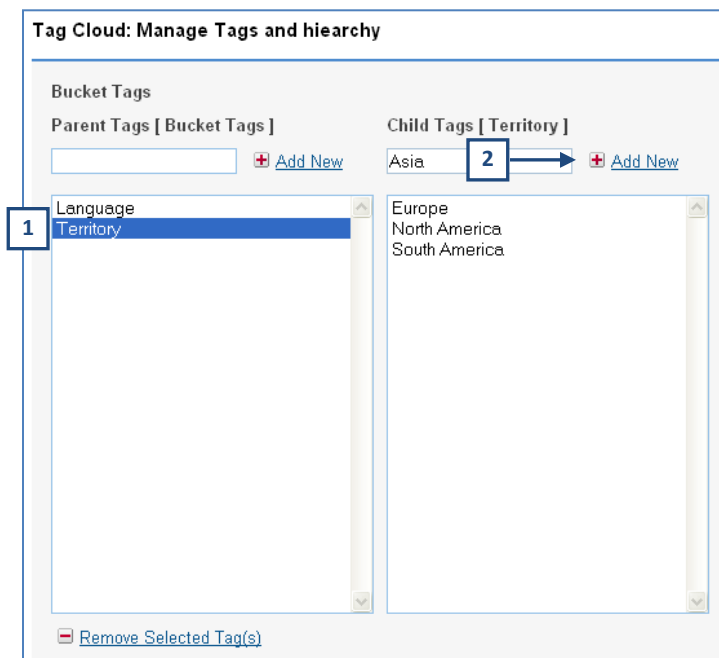
# intelecrm Manage Tag Cloud



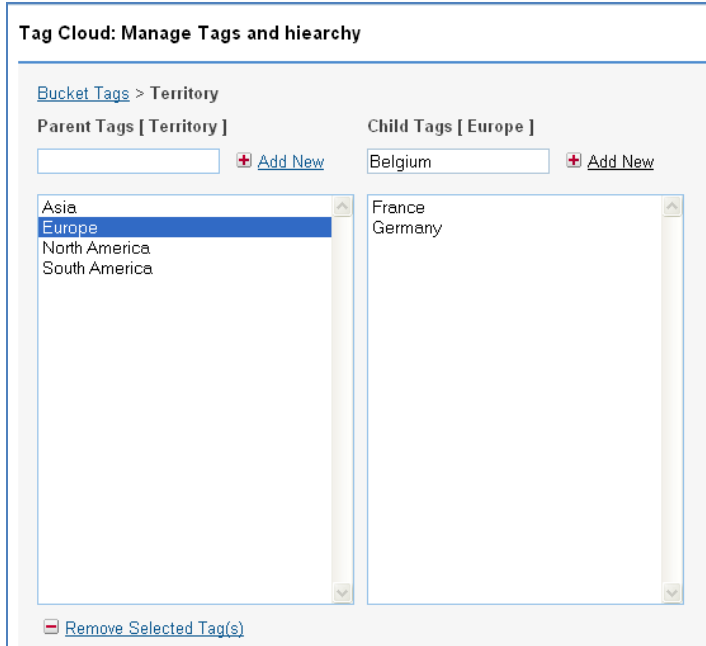
Use the Tag Cloud Subpanel to manage and create new Tag Cloud items within the Admin area.



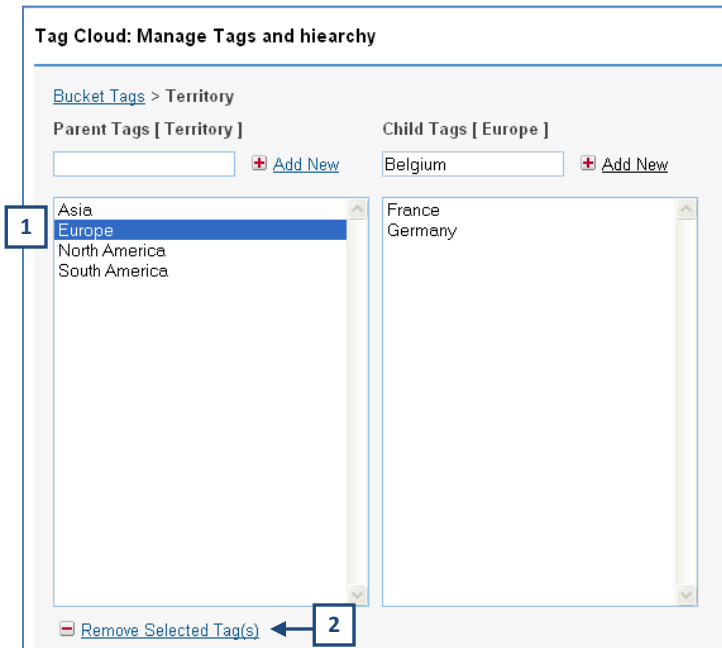
Create a main Parent tag by typing in the Parent name [1] and click the 'Add New' link [2].



To add child tags, simply highlight the Parent Tag you want to populate [1], and enter the children under the 'Child Tags' field [2]. Click the 'Add New' link to add the child.



You can add any number of sub-relationships. IE: you can add children to the children



To remove a tag, simply highlight the tag(s) you want to remove [1] and click the 'Remove Selected Tag(s)' link [2].
